Asbestos in UK's state schools is 'national scandal' say MPs

The All-Party Parliamentary Group on Occupational Safety and Health has called the presence of asbestos in most UK state schools a 'national scandal'.

In a report, it warned that 75 per cent of state schools are exposing children, teachers and other staff to the carcinogenic material.

MPs are calling on the Government to introduce a programme to clear the material from schools.

Their report also recommended updating parents, teachers and staff annually about asbestos in their schools and reinstating inspections into asbestos management.

Jim Sheridan, the group's chairman, said: 'This is a national scandal. Urgent action is needed to prevent more pupils, teachers and other staff being exposed to this deadly killer dust.'

'We need both far greater awareness of the risks that this material poses and a programme for its phased removal.'

More than 140 teachers have died from the rare asbestos-related cancer mesothelioma in the past 10 years.

The Joint Union Asbestos Committee, a campaigning committee comprising the six main education unions, is urging the Government to abandon its plans to make the governors of all state-funded schools responsible for the health and safety of their pupils and staff, which will happen if it transfers responsibilities from local authorities.

Christine Blower, general secretary of the National Union of Teachers, said: 'Governors will be left to manage school buildings – around three quarters of which contain asbestos – without access to local authority support and expertise. This is a huge responsibility. With the UK having the highest incidence of mesothelioma deaths in the world, and with teacher deaths from mesothelioma increasing year on year, asbestos exposure in schools is a grave concern.'

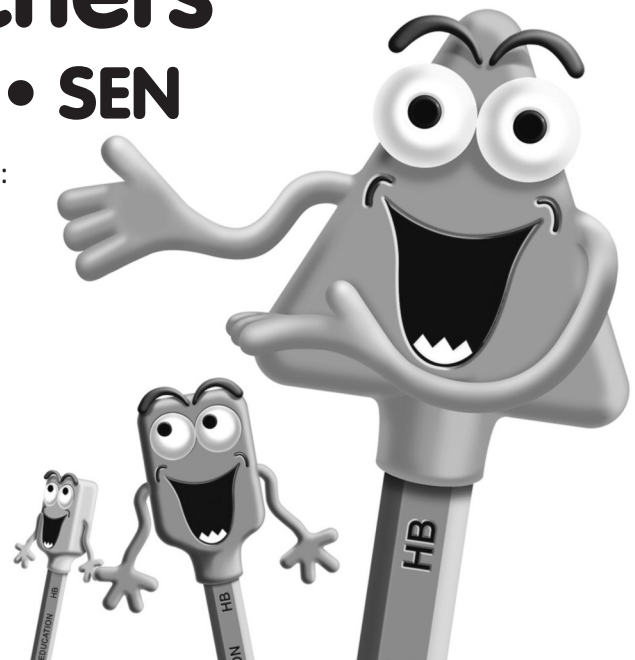

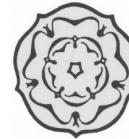
